OBJECTIVE	To recognize and locate matter in three states – solid, liquid, and gas.		
DEFINITIONS	solid:	a substance that holds its own shape and has volume	C
	liquid: gas:	<ul> <li>(e.g., a pencil is a solid)</li> <li>a substance that cannot hold its own shape, but has volume.</li> <li>(e.g., juice is a liquid)</li> <li>a substance that has no shape or volume</li> <li>(e.g., water vapor is a gas)</li> </ul>
